juniper berries, which accounts for its tangy crispness & refreshing attributes. There are	
various styles of gin, London dry being the most popular.	
Whilst juniper tends to be the dominant flavour, other botanicals can be used to make gin, &	
there is no limit to what can be used – these often include anise, liquorice root, saffron,	
cinnamon, cassia bark & orris root. The term "gin" might derive from either the Dutch	
"jenever" or the French "genivre" – both of which mean juniper.	
Gin can be made with any neutral spirit, so production methods can vary greatly. It is how	
the spirit is flavoured that marks the difference between the various styles.
